Graduate Course Credit Exemption Regulations of the Department of Philosophy

Article 1: These regulations are established according to the university's "Credit Exemption Regulations."

Article 2: Graduate students of this department who have passed (with a score of 70 or above) relevant courses at this university or other institutions within the past ten years, and these credits were not counted towards a previous degree's minimum graduation credit requirement, may apply for credit exemption.

Article 3: Applications for credit exemption must be submitted within the first year of enrollment, and only one application per student is allowed.

Article 4: The courses for which graduate students of this department apply for credit exemption must be confirmed by the departmental affairs meeting before approval is granted.

- -4.2Graduate students can be exempted for up to 18 credits at most.
- -4.3 For graduate students who withdraw and re-enter within two academic years, they must complete at least 6 credits of coursework after re-enrollment, with the rest of the eligible exempted credits being fully exempt.
- -4.4Master's In-Service Program students, whether new or re-entering, can exempt all eligible exemptable credits.

Article 5: Any matters not covered by these regulations will be handled in accordance with relevant regulations of the Ministry of Education and the university.

Article 6: These regulations were approved by the departmental affairs meeting and implemented after being reported to and ratified by the academic affairs meeting. The same process applies for any amendments.
