NCU Practices Governing the Management and Charging of
Air-Conditioning Facilities at Student's Dormitory

Passed by the 399th executive meeting on December 22, 2003.

Revised and passed by the 637th executive meeting on July 11, 2016.

Article 1 In order to improve the air-conditioning quality of student dormitory at our school, the practice is specially devised to secure student's equity.

Article 2 The scope of application for this practice include all student dormitories with air-conditioning facilities installed.

Article 3 The installation of air-conditioning facilities, repair & maintenance, depreciation, and other related costs borne to the school should be collected from the students in installment on a yearly or periodic basis. The aforesaid expenses should be decided by the review panel of the student dormitory and be carried out after passed by the executive meeting.

Article 4 The usage of air-conditioner at the dorm room should be based on the user-pays principle. All electrical bill generated should be shared among all students of the same room.

Article 5 Students in each dormitory should be responsible for the safekeeping and maintenance of the air-conditioning facilities (including the air-conditioner in the dorm room, the remote controller of the air-conditioner, and the rating system). Should there be any damage born to the air-conditioning facilities unrelated to the human factors, the case should be reported for repair according to the school's regulated procedure.

Article 6 The users should be responsible for the cleaning of the air-conditioner filter so that it can be maintained in a good condition. The professional or periodic maintenance of the air-conditioner should be reported according to the school's regulated procedures.

Article 7 If the air-conditioning facilities of the dorm room are damaged due to human factor or that the rating system is damaged due to voluntary dismantling, the person in charge should be responsible for the repair and compensation. Based on the degree of damage, the management unit may ask the student to check-out of the dorm room and turn the case over to the Student Reward and Punishment Committee.

Article 8 This practice should come into force after been passed and announced by the executive meeting. The case also applies when the practice is revised.
